Acharya, President, AIBPARC and joint convenor, CBPRO covered various issues which include, inter alia, the remarkable happenings in last few months – holding of successful dharna at Delhi, a fruitful meeting with Hon'ble Union Finance Minister being followed by the meeting with IBA officials. He offered in details the activities of AIBPARC and CBPRO in escalating all the issues affecting the interest of the retirees. He also discussed the legal aspects and financial consequences in relation to updation of pension.

Com. S. Sarkar, General Secretary, praised CBSRA for their excellent organisational ability, phenomenal growth in membership in a moribund condition during pandemic and the technical assistance accorded to AIBPARC as and when needed. He also praised the excellent show offered by the organisation and expected that the holding of the conference at Pune would further strengthen the movement of retirees in this part of the country.
