Sub: Updates on M.C. Singla case for Pension Updation pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

We reproduce hereunder the message received by Com. K V Acharya from our Advocate Shri Sewaram for information of our members:

Quote

“The MC Singla case came up for hearing today at about 2.15 pm. We were fully prepared and our whole team led by Dr. Manish Singhvi Sr Adv was in court. The matter was called and at that time The PNB advocate on record informed the Court that Mr. Vikramjit Banerjee, Additional Solicitor General of India, representing PNB in M C Singla case, is appearing in the 9 judges Constitution Bench hearing Sabarimala case today and prayed for taking up the matter next week. Dr. Manish Singhvi submitted that he may be allowed to continue his arguments but the Hon'ble court suggested the arguments in the presence of Additional Solicitor General and has fixed the matter for 15.4.26.”
