Sub: Com. M.U. Pai passed away.

We have received a message from Com. C. Gangadhar Yadav, our Working President, on the passing away of Com. M.U. Pai, the doyen of the movement of Officers and the Retirees of the Banking Industry. The message is so complete in itself that we reproduce the same as a tribute of AIBPARC to Com. Pai.

With a profound grief we convey the sad news that Com. M U Pai is no more. The passing away of Comrade Malpe Upendra Pai is an irreparable loss to the bank retirees movement and to all of us who had the privilege of working with him.

From his early days in Syndicate Bank, he stood with courage and conviction, even facing dismissal in 1965 for his union activities. Rising as the General Secretary of SBOA, he went on to shape the very destiny of the officers' movement—not only in Syndicate Bank, but across the banking industry. Alongside stalwarts like Com. R.N. Godbole and Com. S.R. Sengupta, he was instrumental in the formation of AIBOC, leaving a legacy that transformed officers' organisations from welfare clubs into true trade unions.

A visionary, strategist, and ever-smiling mentor, he sacrificed much of his personal life for the welfare of officers, yet never failed to inspire courage and confidence in those around him.

We mourn the loss of a pillar of our movement, extend our heartfelt condolences to his family, and pray for his noble soul to rest in eternal peace.
